1. Treasurer Report

Pizza sales down this month. PTO has cleared ~\$3400 from Music Matters fundraiser.

2. Social Committee

Would like to host a bonfire in May. Group decided a Thursday works best. Alicia will look into dates and location.

3. Music Fundraiser and Music billing

Suggestions for next years auction, put auction number not name. Some were deterred from bidding against teachers. Lauren emailed a list of how much each auction item went for. Experiences with teachers was a big hit. Billing for music teacher: too much prep time with not enough outcome in classroom. Concern with attendance. Need lesson plan before each week. Will email to Ellen, Corrie and Ellen. Teachers will account what happens in class and report back to PTO.

4. Bowling

Donelle has scheduled next Bowling fundraiser April 10 from 12-3pm. Will cost \$15/ticket. Will be located at Vista Entertainment Center. Tickets will go on sale at innovationspto.org. Donelle will distribute tickets the Thursday 4/7 before event.

5. PTO contributions to recess equipment

Julie Sleight has made purchases, Donelle will reimburse for equipment.

6. Art

PTO will sponsor each grade to be entered into SD County Fair. Teachers will need to go online and then be reimbursed. \$12/class. Lauren volunteered to help get art there and back.

7. Fair Trade Fundraiser

8. Field & Fence
